#### Here's what you do

To become a member of the Emergency Dental Care Referral Advantage Program<sup>SM</sup>, fill out the membership form and send or fax it back to us. Once enrolled, you'll need to take the following steps to refer your emergency patients to us.

- Ask your office staff to direct an emergency patient to call us at 402-926-4411 when the patient calls in **during office hours** and you can't work them into your schedule that day.
- Mention us in your after-hours voice message to add information about contacting Emergency Dental Care USA.

**Example:** "If you are calling after office hours and need emergency dental assistance, please call Emergency Dental Care USA at 402-926-4411."

Update your Web site to add a link to our site.

**Example:** "Our practice partners with <u>Emergency Dental Care USA</u> for after-hours emergency care. Please call them at 402-926-4111." Include a link to our site at <a href="http://omahaemergencydental.com/">http://omahaemergencydental.com/</a>.

#### Here's what we'll do

- After we receive your form and enroll you, we'll send you a fee schedule which lists the dental
  fees in your zip code area by ADA code, then breaks them down by percentile. This tool can help
  you compare your rates to those of other dentists in the area to see if they're competitive.
- When your patient comes in, we'll ask who referred them to us. If they mention you by name, we'll provide the dental exam at no charge. The patient will be charged only for the x-ray and treatment.
- After the appointment, we'll send you a copy of the x-ray and summary of treatment so you can update your patient's records and follow up as needed.

### **Continuing education**

Continuing education is vital for the continued success of your practice. You need to stay up to date on the latest dental techniques and meet training requirements as outlined in state law. Your management staff wants to enhance their skills to run your practice as efficiently as possible.

Members of the Emergency Dental Care Referral Advantage Program<sup>SM</sup> will be invited to participate in an in-house continuing education program each year. Nationally recognized speakers will lead sessions for both dentists and office staff. Dentists will earn continuing education credits as well. Michael Obeng received his Doctor of Dental Surgery (D.D.S.) in 1994 from Creighton University in Omaha, Nebraska. Immediately following graduation he opened a private practice. To promote his practice, he ran a small Yellow Pages advertisement that included the line, "Emergencies Welcome." As a result he noticed that on just about every weekend, he would receive two or three calls from patients requesting emergency services.

Dr. Obeng also made the commitment to take walk-in patients anytime they came into the office. This became a common theme, with patients commenting that he was one of the few dentists who was willing to see them on an emergency basis.

In fall 1995, an urgent care facility opened up across the street from Dr. Obeng's private practice. Impressed because patients were seen almost immediately, Dr. Obeng realized that this model could be applied to dentistry. His research showed that an emergency dental facility did not exist - and an idea was born.

In early 1996 Dr. Obeng approached a friend about developing his emergency dental concept. The friend agreed, and in September 1996 Dr. Obeng and the friend opened a stand-alone Emergency Dental clinic.

Dr. Obeng felt that it was important that his private practice be separate from the emergency facility. He wanted other dentists to know that any patients referred to him for emergency services would be sent back to their regular dentist for continuing care.

Over time, Dr. Obeng has refined the Emergency Dental Care USA system and believes in it wholeheartedly.

"At Emergency Dental Care USA, patients are extremely appreciative of the services we provide," he says. "You are really performing a wonderful service to the community and as a result, it is satisfying."
